LEARNING EXPERIENCE DESIGNER

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Twenty years of teaching, curriculum design, and program assessment in higher education, now building self-directed e-learning. Six courses built from scratch and years of asynchronous authoring in an enterprise LMS. Also a professional composer, commissioned to design musical works to a brief, on deadlines that do not move.

SELECTED PROJECT

Conscious Discipline at Home – self-directed e-learning module

2026

- A 35–40 minute module teaching parents a de-escalation practice, with written role-play responses scored against a four-criterion rubric.
- Built the knowledge check as four integrative scenarios instead of one item per principle: 1:1 mapping tests recall of the module's structure, not transfer.
- When composure fails, the other three criteria are withheld rather than part-credited — the rule is visible in the feedback, never published as a rubric.
- Reported results as performance bands rather than percentages, so a practice attempt reads as feedback and not a verdict on the parent.

EXPERIENCE

Florida State University College of Music – Visiting Teaching Faculty; Adjunct Lecturer

2023–2026

- Sole designer of three undergraduate and two graduate courses, authoring every assessment in Canvas across 50–60 students per semester.
- Translated dense theoretical scholarship into lecture decks for musicians who are not theorists, each built around a problem the audience wants solved rather than a topic to be covered.
- Rebuilt a graduate course after the placement exam it remediated was eliminated — graduate musicians needed depth and critical thinking, not a second pass through undergraduate material.

Georgia State University School of Music – Faculty Lecturer; Director of Undergraduate Studies

2018–2022

- Directed undergraduate studies for roughly 350 students with 40 full-time and 25 part-time faculty, and chaired the committee responsible for undergraduate curriculum.
- Collected and reported assessment data across five course sections against six and seven scored criteria; the comparison identified a grader scoring consistently harder than peers, corrected the following year.
- Audited curricula against career-readiness competencies and reported where courses fell short, as one of four College of the Arts fellows on the university's Quality Enhancement Plan.
- Built and taught asynchronous courses in D2L Brightspace through the remote transition: recorded and captioned video lectures, authored quizzes and discussion boards, and monitored participation with engagement analytics.

Opera Philadelphia 2016 — created content for a massive open online course accompanying an opera premiere, and delivered public lectures translating specialist material for general audiences.

Private instruction and adult education 2004–2018 — designed individualized curricula for adult learners; created, marketed, and taught *Music Literacy for Music Lovers*, a non-credit course for voluntary adult learners.
